This year, in addition to Urban Treaty Payments at The Forks National Historic Site in Winnipeg taking place June 13-16 and June 19-20, Urban Treaty Payments will also be offered in Thompson, Churchill and Brandon.

From May 2 to 4, staff from Indigenous and Northern Affairs Canada will deliver treaty payments and provide assistance with Registration and Secure Certificate of Indian Status applications in Thompson.

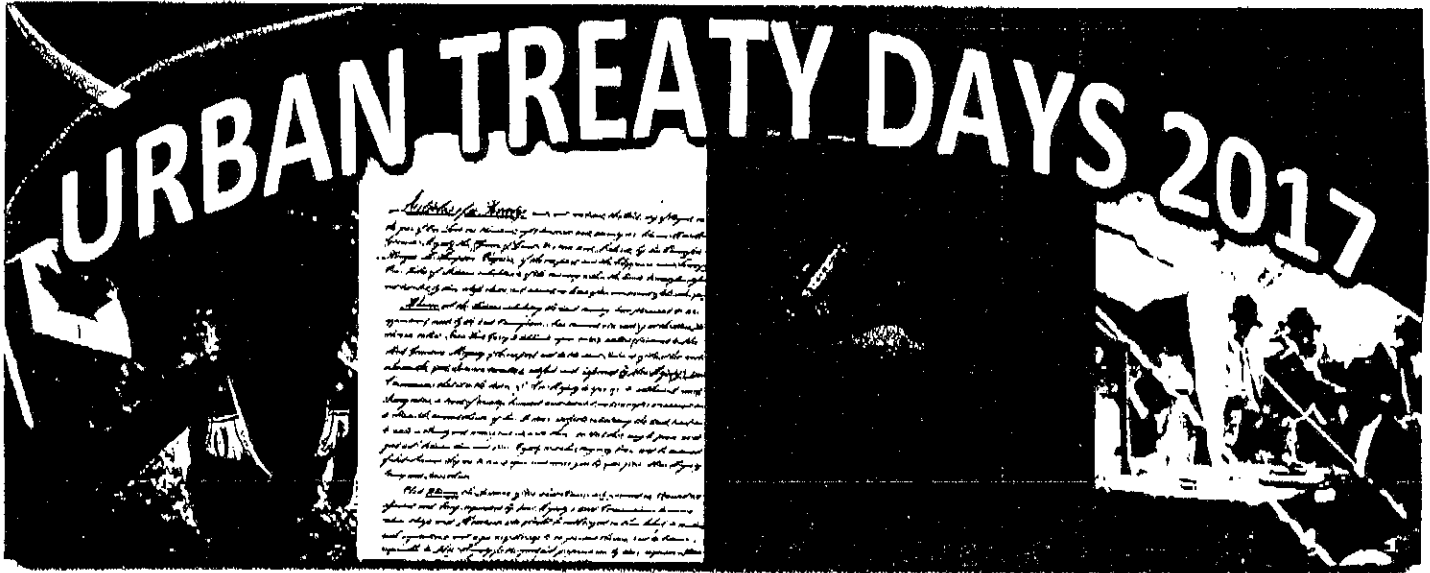

Assistance with Registration and Secure Certificate of Indian Status applications will also be offered to all First Nations members.

Requirements for Treaty Payments

ADULTS (18+) – Photo ID required

- Status card (preferred)
- Driver's license with photo
- Passport
- Valid student card with photo
- Other valid government-issued photo ID (i.e. MPI or MLCC card, or PAL/firearm license)

ADULT COLLECTING FOR MINORS (17 or younger) – Photo ID required for adult

- Minor's status card
- Minor's passport
- Minor's birth certificate listing adult as parent
- Manitoba Health card listing adult and minor on same card

MINORS (13 to 17-years-old)

- Can collect for themselves with appropriate photo ID as listed above
