For many decades, First Nations have wanted a school curriculum that would support their local way of life, language and culture. The Manitoba First Nations Education Resource Centre (MFNERC) has drafted a framework to begin developing this curriculum. The First Nations Curriculum Framework (FNCF) is a document that outlines knowledge, skills and values that can help communities teach First Nations children - who they are, where they come from, and where they are going. The MFNERC would like to make a presentation on the draft curriculum framework at your First Nation in order to hear your feedback and seek your recommendations for further development. A community meeting has been planned for this event.
