

**SARAH VOLUNTEER  
TRAINING OPPORTUNITY  
October & November 2017**

The SARAH Program is a sexual assault crisis intervention program that provides services through regional hospital emergency departments, RCMP detachments and our offices in eastern Manitoba. Survivor's Hope Crisis Centre have been helping victims of sexualized violence since 2003.

The SARAH Program volunteer offers a victim of sexualized violence support, information and referrals to help with the recovery process. We are currently looking for new volunteers to join our SARAH Program to support program centres on the west side of the region (Selkirk & Beausejour) and the east side (Pinawa & Pine Falls). You are invited to explore this volunteer opportunity if you live within 45 minutes of our major centres in Selkirk and Pine Falls.

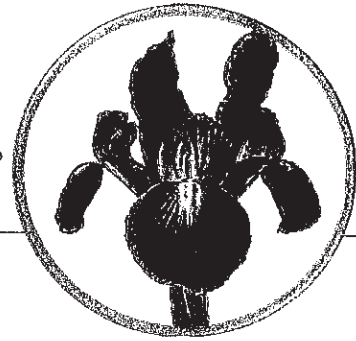
Suitable applicants will be invited to participate in Sexual Assault Crisis Intervention training. All regional applicants will train together to complete 40 hours of training over 3 Saturdays, 2 Sundays and 2 evenings. Training is set for October 21 & 22 (9:00-5:00 Selkirk), 28 & 29 (9:00-5:00 Selkirk), and November 4 (10:00-4:00 Winnipeg). There are two evening training sessions (6:00-9:00) in either Beausejour (Oct 18 & 26) or Pine Falls (Oct 19 & 25). A trainee must attend and complete ALL training sessions before being invited to join our program as a volunteer.

The application process involves completing an application form, attending an in-person interview and providing two reference checks. The applicant must also have a valid driver's license, access to a reliable vehicle, and be willing to travel in eastern Manitoba. A current Criminal Records Check/Vulnerable Sector Check (RCMP) must be presented prior to the start of training. Applicants will also be required to complete applications for a Child Abuse Registry Check and an Adult Abuse Registry Check.
