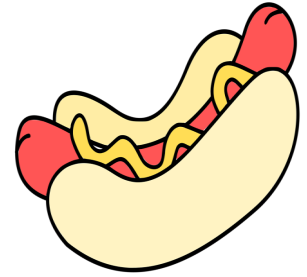

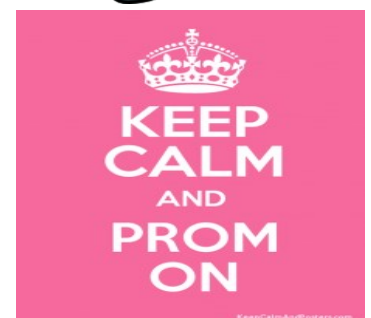
### Jr. Chef Students are Planting Garden Beds
