Grade 8 Robotic Program

The grade 8 classes have the opportunity to take part in a 2 week robotic program which is a certified program for the youth. The robotic program is funded through INAC and is being offered in partnership with Cogmation Robotics and First Peoples Development Inc. The program incorporates STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math) concepts to youth while they build and create Lego mind storm robots. The program introduces student to a field of computer technology and introduces this field as a post-secondary option. This program will run October 9 to the 20 and December 4 to the 15. Catechism Classes

Catechism classes have started on Monday, September 18, 2017 and they will be running until Wednesday, November 1, 2017. The classes are held at the church every Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays from 1 pm to 3 pm. This is at the request of parents/guardians that have registered their students through the church for these classes. The school transports these students to the church and back to school.

Sagkeeng Anicinabe School Chief and Council Election Criteria:

The purpose of having a Student Body (Chief and Council) election is to promote the following:

- Student Leadership
- Student involvement
- An election process
- Partnerships

Criteria for the elections:

Each classroom will hold a vote in their classroom to nominate 1 candidate from their classroom. The candidate from each class will campaign by flyers, posters and on Thursday, September 29th at 9:15 am students will assemble in the gym to listen to the candidate speeches.

There will be a total of 12 candidates on the voting ballot and it will consist of the following:

- 3 candidates from the grade 4 classes (one from each grade 4 class)
- 3 candidates from the grade 5 classes (one from each grade 5 class)
- 2 candidates from the grade 6 classes (one from each grade 6 class)
- 2 candidates from the grade 7 classes (one from each grade 7 class)

The Chief and Council elections will take place on Thursday, September 29, 2017 starting at 10:00 am and go until 12:00 pm. Classes from grades 3 to 8 will participate in the elections. Bus Slip Request for After School

Sagkeeng Education strives to provide safe and punctual transportation for our children. The safety of our children is of the utmost importance. To maximize student safety and arising from parents'/guardians' shared responsibility for that safety, Sagkeeng Education expects that parents assume responsibility to supervise their children, prior to their children boarding and following their children's departure from the bus.

Recently, our schools have been receiving requests from parents'/guardians to have their children dropped off at alternative places other than their homes. Sagkeeng Education realizes that in some situations parents'/guardians' need to make these arrangements. However, parents'/guardians' need to make these arrangements by calling the school early in the day. The schools have been receiving calls at the end of the school day for students to be dropped off elsewhere. This creates confusion and an unsafe situation for the student. In some cases the messages have been received after the buses have departed from the school and the student is dropped off with no supervision at home. The school will try to do their best to assist parents'/guardians' with their request but ask that parents'/guardians please call the school before 2:00 p.m. and leave a phone number where they can be reached to verify the request.

Bus Safety Reminders for Parents and Children

For parents

Educate your children about bus safety etiquette:

- Teach them to stay away from the three danger zones – the front, sides and back of the bus by staying at least three metres (10 feet) away from the school bus.
- If children must cross the street, they must never cross behind the school bus, they should seek the driver's permission, take five giant steps past the front of the bus and make sure the driver has seen them before crossing.
- Teach them to be mindful of other traffic as well before crossing the road.
- If children drop something near or under the school bus, they should never attempt to retrieve it without the driver's permission.
- Ensure that they get to the bus stop at least five minutes before the school bus arrives.
- Teach them to never run after the school bus if they arrive late at the bus stop.

Teach them to take five giant steps away from the road when the school bus is approaching.

For children

- Always wait until the school bus has come to a complete stop before boarding the bus.
- Line up single file to board the bus.
- Refrain from pushing or shoving on the bus.
- Use the handrail to get on and off the bus.
- Do not throw things.
- Don't eat or drink on the bus.
- Always listen to the school bus driver.
- Stay seated until the bus has come to a complete stop.

Get off the bus in a single file.

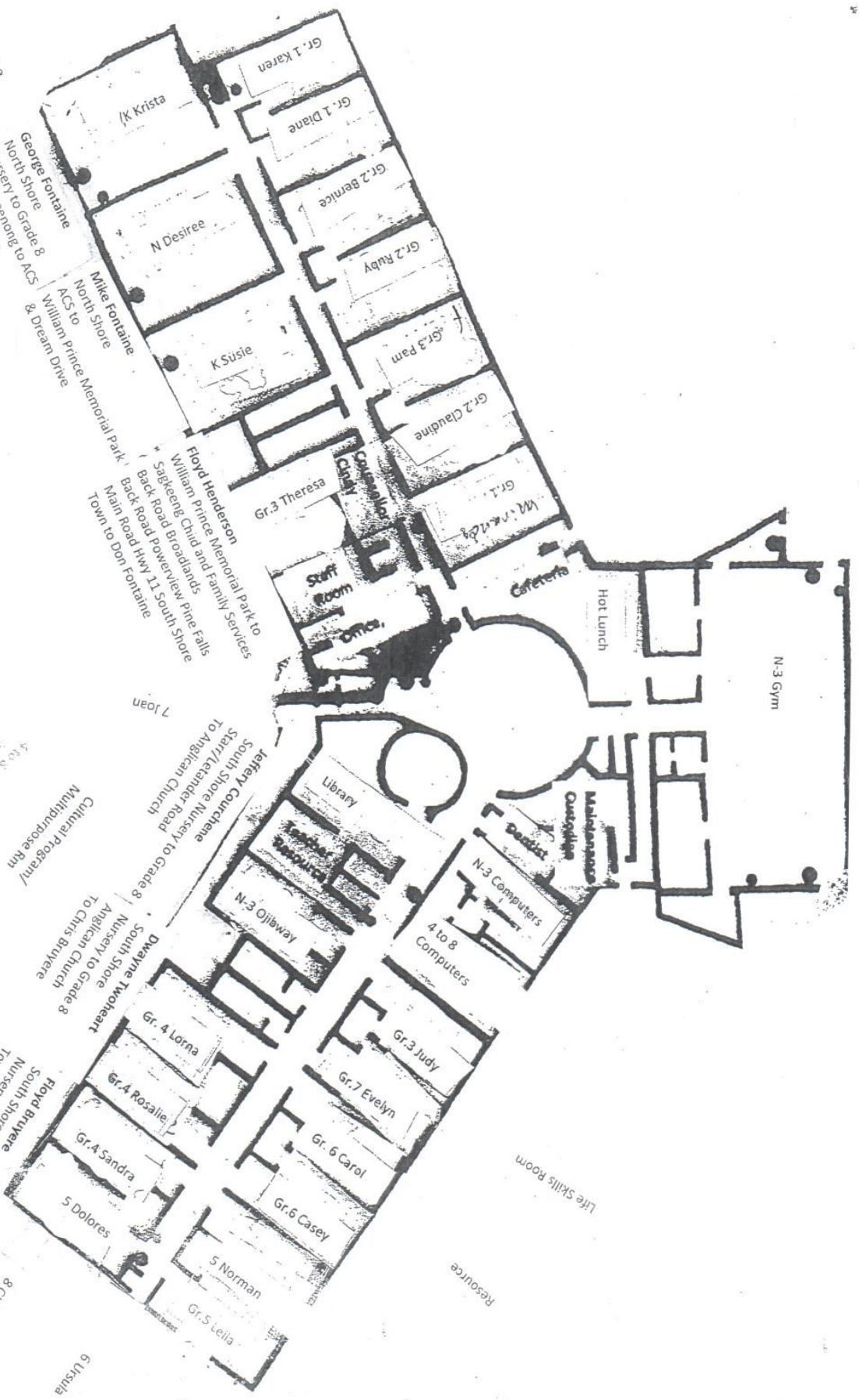
