The Whiteshell Laboratories Closure Project (WLCP) has a mandate to safely decommission the former nuclear research site located near Pinawa, Manitoba by 2024. With this comes a lot of work, work that the project is hoping business and industry both locally and provincially will be interested in.

“We are hosting an industry day to help attract interest in some of the opportunities,” says Dan Coyne WLCP General Manager. “The day will help contractors better understand what services are needed and how to prepare to bid on work.”
