



CONSTRUCTION READINESS PROGRAM

Description

- The Manitoba Construction Sector Council is partnering with Sagkeeng First Nation’s PESF for Youth (18-24) to deliver a four week job readiness program designed for the new entrant or construction laborer.
- Participants learn about the expectations of construction companies and how to retain employment. Following the three week job readiness program, there will be a one week CSAM (Construction Safety Association of Manitoba) Certificate of Recognition (COR) program.
- Because of the program’s national standards, public and private project owners frequently use COR™ as a pre-qualifier or a condition of contract across Canada.
- Clients who successfully complete the program will be introduced and laddered to other training opportunities.
