Sagkeeng Education Department seeks a dynamic physical education teacher to teach its students. Reporting to the Principal of the Sagkeeng Community School the Physical Education Teacher should be an advocate of lifelong health and wellness who also promotes among his/her students a love for fitness, movement, sport, healthy living and cooperative game play.

DUTIES:

- Establish clear and reasonable physical activity expectations and goals for student growth followed by guidance for students and collaboration with parents on achieving those goals including but not limited to:
 - developing motor skills and physical development for younger students
 - proper exercise and eating habits for all students,
- Evaluates and refines the Physical Education curriculum to achieve conformity with best standards and practices,
- Observes students and maintains discipline within the class,
- Participates in professional development as required,
- Performs assigned supervisory duties,
- Collaborates with colleagues,
- Coordinates programs as directed by the Principal,
- Adapt curricula to accommodate children with disabilities, special needs or different physical abilities,
- May have to work outside of regular school hours.
- Other duties as may be assigned from time to time.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- A bachelor's degree or greater in a related discipline from an accredited university or college,
- · Certification from the Province of Manitoba with relevant endorsements,
- Two (2) years or more experience of demonstrated success in teaching Physical Education at the elementary level,
- Equivalent education and experience will be considered.
- Knowledge and familiarity with of physical education and healthy living activities, concepts and practices,
- Demonstrated oral and written communication skills with people of all ages, including the ability to explain demonstrate activities.
- Valid Manitoba Class 5 Driver's licence
- Preference will be given to applicants of Aboriginal / First Nations ancestry with first preference given to members of Sagkeeng First Nation.
