POSITION OVERVIEW

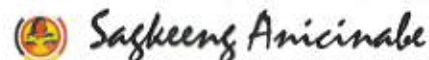
Reporting to the Principal the teacher shall be an educational leader in the classroom and ensure that the School's Programs and curricula are implemented in a way that maximizes student-learning experiences. Reporting to the Principal, as part of a team of professionals, the Teacher will be responsible for supervision and evaluation of all students within his/her teaching assignment.

DUTIES:

- Work collaboratively with administration to plan, organize, and adapt lessons to meet the needs of the students while meeting the requirements of the curriculum for Computer Science,
- Work with a student one-on-one, in a small group and whole group setting and provide tutoring assistance and support student academic success,
- Ensure the students have a positive, and encouraging classroom environment and a healthy educational experience,
- Assess students' skills to determine their needs and to develop teaching plans,
- Develop course content,
- Prepare subject material for presentation according to an approved curriculum,
- Prepare, administer and correct tests,
- Monitor students' progress work with them individually and in groups so that they grasp and understand the course material,
- Discuss student's progress with parents, counsellors, and administration,
- Teach students through lectures, discussions, audio-visual presentations and laboratory, shop and field studies as required,
- Participate in staff meetings, educational conferences, and teacher training workshops,
- Evaluate the progress of students and discuss results with students, parents and school officials,
- Ensuring that the Computer Lab is only used constrictively by students authorized to be there,
- Other duties within scope of the position as required.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Bachelor of Education preferred, though a combination of relevant education, training, and experience may be considered,
- Experience with computers, peripherals, various programming languages, and software programs,
- Must be certified or eligible for certification,
- Several years' experience working with children, youth, and teens,
- Experience working with children with special needs is an asset,
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills,
- Familiarity and comfort with the subject material they are to teach,
- Attention to detail,
- Highly motivated and committed to student learning,
- Good team work ethics and ability to act as a role model to youth. As a role model for youth, it is imperative that you are living a healthy, drug-free lifestyle,
- Clear criminal record and abuse registry checks,
- Valid Driver's licence and reliable vehicle,
- Preference will be given to people of First Nations ancestry.
