Notice to Sagkeeng Community

RE: Fire Burn Ban in effect & Scrap Metal

The spring/summer season is fast approaching. Community members have already begun grass burning. The Sagkeeng Government Office and the Sagkeeng Fire Dept is reaching out to community members to be mindful of debris in their yards. The debris and scrap material pose as a fire risk. At this time, Sagkeeng will be under a **Fire Burn Ban**.

We are concerned about the Grass Fires that individuals are setting and not watching them. At this time, we are asking the community members to **refrain** from making grass fires. The Fire Dept will be doing Control Grass Burning.

We are asking community members to be patient; we have two fire crews working at the moment to do the control fires. We are working on the ditches, then we will get to people's yards.

Also, if you have any **scrap metal** that you would like to have removed from your yard, the Sagkeeng Fire Dept is willing to pick up and remove at no cost to you. The Fire Dept will be picking up scrap starting April 29 – May 20.


