We are looking for someone who is excellent at planning and organizing activities, knows the community, traditions and resources and is able to create and deliver land-based healing activities. No formal education or training required!

DUTIES

- The land-based healing leader works and networks in order to find experts and elders in the community who will deliver or assist with the development and delivery of weekend land healing activities.
- Document all activities and events during each shift according to program policy
- Provide regular reports to program manager.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Speaks Ojibwe
- Familiar with and knowledgeable of the community and its resources of people and places,
- Understands land based healing and can develop and provide activities for same,
- Experience working with, supervising, and/or parenting children of all ages,
- Ability and willingness to work with children and youth with disabilities,
- Ability to work evenings and weekends to lead and manage activities.
- Experience providing care and support to persons with disabilities of any age is an asset
- Valid Class 5 MB driver's license and access to a reliable vehicle are required
- Clean and current Vulnerable Sectors Check and Child Abuse Registry Check are required
- Training in First Aid/CPR, Food Handler's, and Non-Violent Crisis Intervention is an asset, but training will be provided
- Preference will be given to applicants of Aboriginal / First Nations ancestry, with first preference to Sagkeeng band members
