## COVID-19 CHECK POINTS

**SAGKEENG FIRST NATION April 5, 2020** – the Chief and Council are empowered to act on behalf of the Sagkeeng First Nation community. We have exclusive jurisdiction providing peace, order and good governance by implementing precautionary measures with respect to COVID-19 Pandemic that would maintain the safety and secure environment to its members. Members from the community can still travel outside the community but remain in the Province of Manitoba and adhere to the limit of no more than 10 people at any indoor or outdoor place or premise and the travel is essential.

**Sagkeeng will be implementing check points as of Monday, April 6, 2020 at 7:00 am.**

There will be 3 check points, West Side Hwy 11 (Cat Fish Creek), East Side Hwy 11 (Pine Falls) and the North Shore Road. All vehicles must disclose names of all in the vehicle coming into the community will be screened and asked a minimal amount of questions such as if you travelled and if so where.

Essential travel will continue for medical appointments and employees who work in the community will still have access to and from their place of work.

The check points will remain in effect from April 6 to April 20, 2020 and will be reassessed if an extension is necessary.
