Sagkeeng Anicinabe Government is looking for Peace Officers (Full-time and Part-time Positions)

Reporting to the Director, Peace Officers are responsible for providing safety and security for Sagkeeng First Nation by enforcing various laws, bylaws and rules and building positive Community and professional relationships through proactive policing, security and safety initiatives.

DUTIES:

- Serve legal documents including but not limited to Band Council Resolutions,
- Provide security and crowd control as needed.
- Enforce laws, by-laws, regulations, rules, and appropriate behaviours as assigned, and take appropriate enforcement, mediation or other corrective actions as required.
- Perform and assist in search and rescue functions,
- Complete occurrence and supplementary reports as required,
- Direct traffic in emergency situation;
- Work with the community and others in development of crime prevention, recreation and community wellness programs which enhance public safety,
- Work with the RCMP and other law enforcement groups as required,
- Travel and work outside of the community as assigned or required,
- Other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Grade 10 education,
- Must have a valid Class 4 or greater valid Manitoba Driver's licence or be willing to get one as a condition of employment,
- First Aid/CPR training is an asset, and will be required once employment begins or shortly thereafter,
- Must be in very good health,
- Strong interpersonal and verbal communications skills,
- Ability to multi-task in a high stress and time driven environment by setting priorities and meeting deadlines,
- Demonstrated ability to work both independently and as part of a team,
- Must be willing to work a flexible work schedule including being able to work evenings/weekends as required;
- Must be able to take and satisfactorily complete various training,
- Experience using computers and software,
- Ability to think quickly on your feet, think fast,
- Strong negotiation ability,
- Formal training in security and/or criminology, or dispute resolution is an asset,
- Preference will be given to applicants of Aboriginal / First Nations ancestry.
