Detailed Description of Levels:

The following may be considered if this alert is applied:

- Absolutely no gatherings.
- Only long-term residents and essential staff will be permitted on reserve (262 members living in Winnipeg should not be permitted to enter the community at this time)
- Sagkeeng members will be permitted to leave or enter **SFN** for medical emergencies and for grocery/supplies pick up. Permit each household to only leave their residence only once per day to shop in Pine Falls/Powerview. (Pine Falls/Powerview is part of our designated bubble)
Every Friday, the lockdown is relaxed to allow two people per household to travel to nearby communities for essential shopping.
- No visitations at the George M. Personal Care Home.
- Katrina Rae Daycare will be closed.
- K-12 Schools are to remain at level 3, closed with remote learning.
- SFN offices remain closed and staff work from home.
- Essential businesses are to remain open, with added restrictions and reduced hours (i.e. Sagkeeng Superstore, Public Works, etc.).
- Private businesses that are essential are to remain open, but with reduced hours and with continued restrictions in place.
- Funerals and wake will be for immediate family only to a maximum of 10 at one time. Public health orders to be followed and contact tracing.
- VLT's will be closed.
- Masks and hand washing/sanitizing are mandatory.
- Social distancing at 2 meters at all times.
- Absolutely no visiting in the community amongst community members.
- Community curfew to remain from 10:00 pm to 8 am, failure to comply with the curfew will result in a fine of \$100.
- SFN Checkpoints will remain in place with contact tracing questions.

ORDER OF SAGKEENG ANICINABE GOVERNMENT

WHEREAS the Chief and Council of the Sagkeeng First Nation are empowered by the people to act on behalf of the First Nation and are recognized as having such authority by the Government of Canada; and,

WHEREAS the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) is an infectious disease caused by severe acute respiratory syndrome (SARS-CoV-2) and has resulted in a global pandemic; and,

WHEREAS the growing number of COVID-19 cases in the province of Manitoba is of great concern to the Chief and Council for the Sagkeeng community members; and,

WHEREAS the Chief and Council of the Sagkeeng First Nation have decided at a duly convened meeting October 26 2020, that they will implement a COVID Alert Levels act for the Sagkeeng First Nation; and,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Chief and Council of the Sagkeeng First Nation has declared that the community is in code **LEVEL RED**, effective November 12, 2020.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Chief and Council of Sagkeeng First Nation have extended a closure effective immediately for the community and its members, as a precautionary measure to reduce the risk of spreading COVID-19.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Chief and Council of Sagkeeng First Nation will re-evaluate the Community Closure **December 12, 2020**.
