General Duties:

Qualifications:

- Persons committed to the objectives of the Agency.
- Have the ability to actively participate in Board deliberations.
- Exhibit a demonstrated commitment to leading a lifestyle consistent with the mandate of the Agency.
- Must be a registered member of Sagkeeng First Nation and reside in the Province of Manitoba.
- Are not members of a Board or employees of any Child and Family Services Agency governed by the Southern First Nations Network of Care.
- Are not members of any other Sagkeeng First Nation Board.
- Willing to abide by the conflict-of-interest policy and guidelines of the Agency.
- Willing to commit to a minimum 4 (four) year term.
- Are not the Chief or member of the Band Council of Sagkeeng First Nation
- Must be able to provide clear Criminal Records Checks, Prior Contact Checks, & Child Abuse Registry Checks.
- Are not in an elected position in a Metis, municipal, provincial, or federal government.
- Are not a former employee of the Agency whose employment ended unless five (5) full years has expired since the date of termination.
- Are not a care provider licensed by Sagkeeng CFS or providing care for children in the care of Sagkeeng CFS.

Qualified candidates will be required to undergo a criminal record check, child abuse registry check, and a prior contact check.
