SUBJECT: CANADA EMERGENCY RESPONSE BENEFIT (CERB)

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It was brought to our attention that community members ineligible for the CERB have applied for this Government of Canada aided fund.

For your information CERB is jointly delivered by Service Canada and the Canada Revenue Agency. If you have stopped working because of COVID-19, the CERB may provide a temporary income support.

Eligibility for CERB is available to workers:

- Residing in Canada, who are at least 15 years old;
- Who have stopped working because of reasons related to COVID-19 or are eligible for Employment Insurance regular or sickness benefits or have exhausted their Employment Insurance regular benefits or Employment Insurance fishing benefits between December 29, 2019 and October 3, 2020;
- Who had employment and/or self-employment income of at least \$5,000 in 2019 or in the 12 months prior to the date of their application and,
- Who have not quit their job voluntarily.

Please be advised that it is your responsibility to review the eligibility requirements.
