Detailed Description of Levels:

The following may be considered if this alert is applied:

- All SFN businesses are to remain at a capacity of 25%.
- Visitations at the George M. Guimond Personal Care Home are available, an appointment must be made and strict health protocols are in place for visitors.
- Katrina Rae Daycare is open, with health protocols in place for all staff and clientele.
- K-12 Schools are open with the designated groups and cohorts, health protocols are in place for all staff and students.
- Sagkeeng Superstore is now open to non-band members. Masks, hand sanitization and social distancing remain mandatory and contact tracing questions will be asked.
- SFN offices are open regular hours but not open to the general public. Appointments must be made if necessary.
- Private businesses that are essential are to remain open with continued public health protocols in place.
- Funerals and wakes to a maximum of 25 people and masks mandatory.
- VLT's are now open with barriers in place and capacity limits. Masks remain mandatory and contact tracing questions will be asked.
- Homeowners must choose either one household or two individuals, as designated visitors to their home. Up to 10 people are permitted to gather outside on private property.
- Hand sanitization, social distancing and wearing masks when in a public area are to remain mandatory.
- SFN Checkpoints have been removed as of April 15, 2021. The Checkpoints will be enforced if there is any community transmission, or rising cases of COVID-19 and if there are any reported cases of the new variants of COVID-19.
- Community curfew to remain from 11 pm to 6 am, failure to comply with the curfew may result in a fine.
