COVID-19 CHECK POINT & CURFEW

SAGKEENG FIRST NATION April 28, 2021 – the Chief and Council are empowered to act on behalf of the Sagkeeng First Nation community. We have exclusive jurisdiction providing peace, order and good governance by implementing precautionary measures with respect to COVID-19 Pandemic that would maintain the safety and secure environment to its members.

The 3 check points will be set up as of **Friday, April 30, 2021** at West Side Hwy 11 (Cat Fish Creek), East Side Hwy 11 (Pine Falls) and the North Shore Road. All vehicles will be screened and asked a minimal amount of questions. Any passengers in vehicle will also be screened.

All are welcome to shop and fuel at the community stores however uncooperative individuals with our checkpoint staff will be turned away. Masks, hand sanitizing and contact tracing are mandatory.

A curfew from 10:00 pm to 6:00 am will be implemented.

The check points and curfew will remain in effect from April 28 to May 26, 2021 and will be reassessed if an extension is necessary.
